The Village of Chadwick would like to remind residents that it is against City Ordinance to blow grass clippings into the street when mowing your lawn. The grass clippings accumulate in the storm sewers and plug them up during heavy rain storms. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

Effective with the June 21st Water/Sewer/Garbage bill, a graduated infrastructure fee will be in place. A \$5.00 Capital Improvement Fee will be added per month in addition to your regular charges until May 2020 when the amount will be \$7.50 per month, and in May 2021 the amount will be \$10.00 per month.

The Village of Chadwick is hosting a Pavilion/Playground Equipment fundraiser, June 9th, from 10:30 A.M. to 2:00 P.M. You get 3 corn shell tacos and a drink for \$7.00. M & K will be serving tacos from their food stand on Main Street. Vendors will be set up on the Hall lawn and we will be having a Bake Sale too!
