Village of Chadwick Bulky Waste Clean Up 2019

Moring Disposal will be providing the Bulky Waste Clean-up Day for all homes in the Village of Chadwick.

Program Date: Saturday, July 20th - All acceptable bulk waste should be set at the curb the night before or by 6:00 a.m. Items set out after the truck has passed will not be collected.

Waste Collection Limit: Each participating residence may set out up to two (2) large bulky items and one (1) cubic yard of miscellaneous waste (**equivalent to approximately six 35 gallon garbage containers**).

Program Guidelines: Miscellaneous bulk waste should be contained in bags or boxes. Uncontained items will not be collected. Large appliances, electronics, and construction material are prohibited. The following are detailed lists of acceptable and unacceptable items.

*Please note that electronic items are now banned from Illinois landfills. Look for county or other publicly sponsored drop off recycling events for your expired e-waste items. You can also go to www.moringdisposal.com and click the "e-recycling solutions" link for other options available to you on recycling your e-waste.

ACCEPTABLE (BULKY)

- Couches
- Sectional - (limit (1) full sectional)
- Sleeper sofas
- Rocker/recliners
- Coffee/end tables
- Kitchen tables
- Bed frames
- Mattress/box springs
- Baby beds (cribs)
- Bicycles
- Swing Sets (Broken down to max 4 ft.)
- Dressers, shelving, cabinets etc.

ACCEPTABLE MISC. ITEMS

- Boxes or cans of small items including:
- Bikes, tricycles, outdoor toys, lawn tools, lawn chairs, baby swings, playpens, walkers, child car seats, fans, dishes, clothing, vacuum cleaners, pillows, picture frames, area rugs, etc.

UNACCEPTABLE (BULKY)

- Major appliances

- Electronic Items (TV's, computers, monitors, printers, faxes, DVD players, VHS players, microwaves, etc.)
- Air conditioners
- De-humidifiers
- Water heater/softener
- Windows
- Plate glass
- All lawn mowers
- Tires
- Grills
- Demolition/remodeling debris
- Cement, rock, brick
- Carpeting
- Car parts

UNACCEPTABLE MISC. ITEMS

- Electronic Items (Cellular phones, mp3 players, radios, etc.)
- Auto batteries
- Liquid waste of any kind
- Household hazardous waste
- Medical waste
- Solid steel posts
- All heavy gauge steel
- Yard waste
